Such changes may reflect positively on the project's overall score, depending on the quality of the provided explanation (particularly with regard to the beneficiary's Erasmus Plan objectives).

The total grant for international activities (activities involving third countries not associated to the Programme) cannot exceed the amount indicated above under 'Maximum grant for international activities'. Budget categories 'Inclusion support for participants' and 'Exceptional costs for expensive travel' will not count towards this limit. If the limit is reached, the target number of participants in international activities will not apply.

This project does not involve any supporting organisations. Involvement of any supporting organisations will be subject to approval by the National Agency and a grant agreement amendment.
